Summary

AB2877 proposes amendments to the California Consumer Privacy Act concerning artificial intelligence training. The bill is inactive and died in committee.

Business Impact

The bill does not specify direct actions or consequences for businesses.

Key Provisions

- Amends Sections 1798.99.90, 1798.121, 1798.130, 1798.140, 1798.145, 1798.185, 1798.199.40
- Adds Section 1798.199.41 to the Civil Code
