California Unconditional Benefit Program: employment replaced by automation or artificial intelligence: pilot program.

Pilot Program

Last Action (Apr 08, 2024): In committee: Set, first hearing. Hearing canceled at the request of author.

Summary

AB3058 establishes a pilot program to provide \$1,000 monthly to individuals unemployed due to AI or automation, effective until January 1, 2029.

Business Impact

If you employ workers replaced by AI, they may qualify for CalUBI benefits; no direct action required from employers.

Key Provisions

- Establishes the CalUBI Pilot Program (Section 4800).
- Provides \$1,000 monthly for 12 months to eligible individuals (Section 4801(c)).
- Requires regulations by January 1, 2026 (Section 4802).
- Exempts program income from state taxes (Section 4803).
- Mandates a legislative report by December 31, 2028 (Section 4804).
