Generative Artificial Intelligence Accountability Act.

Passed Both Chambers

Risk: Low

Narrow/Targeted

Last Action (Sep 29, 2024): Chaptered by Secretary of State. Chapter 928, Statutes of 2024.

Summary

Authorizes a nonprofit to construct a monument for the 250th Anniversary of the U.S. at the State Capitol.

Business Impact

No direct impact on businesses as it pertains to monument construction.

Key Provisions

- Nonprofit may construct a monument for the 250th Anniversary of the U.S.
- Requires Joint Rules Committee approval of the monument plan.
- Monument must be funded exclusively through private sources.
- Department of General Services to ensure compliance with ADA and safety standards.
- Maintenance agreement required for long-term upkeep of the monument.

Compliance Checklist

- Submit monument plan for approval | Who: Nonprofit organization | Penalty: Cannot begin construction without approval
- Secure private funding for monument | Who: Nonprofit organization | Penalty: Cannot begin construction without funding
