Last Action (Sep 29, 2024): Chaptered by Secretary of State. Chapter 928, Statutes of 2024.

Summary

Establishes accountability standards for generative AI systems in California.

Business Impact

No direct impact on businesses as it pertains to monument construction.

Key Provisions

- Mandates transparency in AI-generated content.
- Establishes ethical guidelines for AI use.
- Designates a state agency for compliance oversight.
- Imposes penalties for non-compliance.
- Requires accountability measures for AI developers and users.

Compliance Checklist

- Submit monument plan for approval | Who: Nonprofit organization | Penalty: Cannot begin construction without approval
- Secure private funding for monument | Who: Nonprofit organization | Penalty: Cannot begin construction without funding
