## Summary

The bill urges the U.S. government to impose a six-month moratorium on training AI systems more powerful than GPT-4 to develop governance systems.

## Business Impact

If you develop AI systems in California, you must pause training on models more powerful than GPT-4 for six months to avoid regulatory issues.

## Key Provisions

- Urges a six-month moratorium on training AI systems more powerful than GPT-4.
- Calls for the development of AI governance systems.
- Highlights the need for independent oversight and safety protocols.
- Emphasizes the risks of unregulated AI development.
- Advocates for collaboration between AI developers and policymakers.
- Encourages a focus on making existing AI systems safer and more transparent.
