Summary

AB2441 would require public transit agencies to notify employees before deploying autonomous transit vehicle technology.

Business Impact

If you operate a public transit agency in California, you must notify employees 12 months before deploying autonomous vehicles or face potential disputes.

Key Provisions

- Requires public transit districts to notify employees before deploying autonomous transit vehicle technology.
- Aims to ensure worker consultation in decisions affecting jobs due to technological changes.

Compliance Checklist

- Negotiate with employee representatives | Who: Public transit agencies | Penalty: Potential disputes or legal challenges
