State government: Artificial Intelligence in State Government Services Commission: report.

Last Action (Feb 03, 2020): From committee: Filed with the Chief Clerk pursuant to Joint Rule 56.

## Summary

AB459 proposed establishing the 'Artificial Intelligence in State Government Services Commission' to oversee AI use in state services and required a report, but it died under Art. IV, Sec. 10(c).

## Business Impact

If you use AI in state services, no immediate action is required as the bill did not pass.

## Key Provisions

- Establishment of the 'Artificial Intelligence in State Government Services Commission' to oversee AI in state services.
- Requirement for a report on AI implementation in state services.
- Addition and repeal of Section 11820.50 of the Government Code related to AI oversight and reporting.
