Summary

AB976 establishes the Artificial Intelligence in State Government Services Commission in California, effective until January 1, 2025.

Business Impact

If you develop AI projects for state services, engage with the commission's public process annually.

Key Provisions

- Establishment of the Artificial Intelligence in State Government Services Commission (Section 11820.15)
- Annual public process to gather input on AI in state services (Section 11820.20(a))
- Proposal for AI demonstration projects (Section 11820.20(b))
- Submission of annual recommendations to the Legislature and Governor (Section 11820.20(d))
- Advisory nature of the commission (Section 11820.25)
