Summary

AB1202 adds Title 1.81.48 to the Civil Code, requiring data brokers in California to register with the state.

Business Impact

If you are a data broker in California, you must register with the state to comply with AB1202.

Key Provisions

- Data brokers must register with the state (Section 1798.99.80).
