## An Act Concerning Artificial Intelligence.

## Summary

The bill establishes requirements for AI systems, creates an advisory council, mandates training on generative AI, and includes initiatives for AI education and computing services.

## Business Impact

If you develop or use AI systems in Connecticut, you must comply with new requirements and training mandates or face penalties.

## Key Provisions

- Establishes requirements for AI system development and use.
- Creates an Artificial Intelligence Advisory Council.
- Prohibits dissemination of certain synthetic images.
- Prohibits distribution of deceptive media concerning elections.
- Mandates state agencies to study generative AI applications.
- Requires training on generative AI for state employees.
- Requires the Commissioner of Administrative Services to provide training on generative AI.
- Requires the Chief Workforce Officer to design a broadband outreach program.

## Compliance Checklist

- Develop and implement AI systems according to new requirements. | Who: Businesses and state agencies involved in AI. | Penalty: Potential penalties for non-compliance.
- Provide training on generative AI to employees. | Who: State agencies and businesses using AI. | Penalty: Potential penalties for non-compliance.
