Summary

The bill establishes an Office of Artificial Intelligence, sets data privacy rules for minors, exempts air carriers, and creates a task force to study AI.

Business Impact

If you process personal data of consumers under 16 in Connecticut, you must obtain consent for targeted advertising or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Establishes an Office of Artificial Intelligence.
- Prohibits processing personal data for targeted advertising without consent for minors aged 13 to under 16.
- Exempts air carriers from certain data privacy provisions.
- Creates a task force to study AI and develop an AI bill of rights.

Compliance Checklist

- Obtain consent for processing personal data of consumers aged 13-15 for targeted advertising. | Who: Controllers processing personal data. | Penalty: Potential penalties for non-compliance.
- Adhere to new data privacy standards as established by the Office of Artificial Intelligence. | Who: Businesses handling personal data. | Penalty: Potential penalties for non-compliance.
