Summary

SB00006 establishes a framework for personal data privacy, granting consumers rights to manage their data and opt out of certain data processing activities.

Business Impact

If you process personal data, you must comply with new privacy standards or face potential legal challenges.

Key Provisions

- Establishes a framework for controlling and processing personal data.
- Grants consumers rights to access, correct, delete, and obtain copies of their personal data.
- Allows consumers to opt out of targeted advertising and certain sales of personal data.
- Sets responsibilities and privacy protection standards for data controllers and processors.
- Focuses on profiling that produces legal or significant effects on consumers.

Compliance Checklist

- Implement processes for consumers to access, correct, and delete their personal data. | Who: Data controllers and processors. | Penalty: Potential penalties for non-compliance.
- Establish opt-out mechanisms for targeted advertising and data sales. | Who: Businesses processing personal data. | Penalty: Potential penalties for non-compliance.
