## Summary

HF4544 proposes the establishment of a license for AI independent verification organizations, defines an advisory council's responsibilities, and authorizes specific rulemaking.

## Business Impact

- Establishes a license for AI independent verification organizations with defined criteria and process.
- Creates an advisory council with specific responsibilities and composition.
- Authorizes rulemaking to develop standards and procedures for licensing within defined limitations.
