Summary

Exempts AI transparency violation investigations from public records requirements in Florida.

Business Impact

If you are investigated for AI transparency violations in Florida, your information may remain confidential.

Key Provisions

- Exemption from public records for AI transparency violation investigations.
- Confidentiality of information post-investigation.
- Future legislative review and potential repeal of the exemption.
- Statement of public necessity for confidentiality.
