HI HB1954: Relating To Identity Theft, focusing on amendments to identity theft laws, including fraudulent impersonation and AI-related offenses. Verified with full bill text.

Business Impact

If you use AI to create media in Hawaii, you must ensure it does not misrepresent individuals or face identity theft charges.

Key Provisions

- The bill includes fraudulent impersonation and false depiction through AI or deceptive media in identity theft offenses.
- The bill specifies penalties and enforcement mechanisms for identity theft offenses.

Compliance Checklist

- Ensure AI-generated media does not misrepresent individuals. | Who: Businesses using AI for media creation. | Penalty: Potential identity theft charges.
