## Summary

The bill exempts fully autonomous vehicles from certain regulations, allowing them to operate without a human driver and establishes insurance and operational requirements. It authorizes the Florida Turnpike Enterprise to enter into agreements to fund and operate facilities.

## Business Impact

If you operate autonomous vehicles in Florida, you must comply with new insurance and operational requirements or face penalties.

## Key Provisions

- Exempts autonomous vehicles from certain prohibitions.
- Human operator not required for fully autonomous vehicles.
- Automated driving system deemed operator when engaged.
- Establishes insurance requirements for autonomous vehicle networks.
- Revises registration requirements for autonomous vehicles.
- Promotes uniformity in laws governing autonomous vehicles.
- Authorizes the Florida Turnpike Enterprise to enter into agreements to fund and operate facilities.

- Ensure insurance coverage meets new requirements for autonomous vehicles. | Who: Operators of autonomous vehicles. | Penalty: Potential penalties for non-compliance.
- Register autonomous vehicles according to revised requirements. | Who: Manufacturers and operators of autonomous vehicles. | Penalty: Potential penalties for non-compliance.
