Summary

This bill prohibits the use of artificial intelligence in making decisions regarding insurance coverage, healthcare, and public assistance in Georgia.

Business Impact

If you use AI in insurance or healthcare decisions in Georgia, you must cease such practices immediately to avoid legal repercussions.

Key Provisions

- Prohibits AI use in insurance coverage, healthcare, and public assistance decisions.
- Requires the Georgia Composite Medical Board to create rules related to healthcare decisions.
- Amends existing laws to ensure compliance with these prohibitions.
- Repeals conflicting laws to maintain clarity.
