Summary

HB887 prohibits the use of artificial intelligence in decisions related to insurance coverage, healthcare, and public assistance in Georgia.

Business Impact

If you use AI in insurance or healthcare decisions in Georgia, you must cease such practices immediately to avoid penalties.

Key Provisions

- Prohibits the use of AI in making decisions regarding insurance coverage.
- Prohibits the use of AI in healthcare decision-making.
- Prohibits the use of AI in public assistance decisions.
- Mandates the Georgia Composite Medical Board to promulgate related rules.
- Repeals conflicting laws.
- Addresses related matters as necessary.

Compliance Checklist

- Cease the use of AI in decision-making processes for insurance, healthcare, and public assistance. | Who: Insurance companies, healthcare providers, and public assistance agencies. | Penalty: Potential legal challenges or sanctions.
