Georgia Technology Authority; annual inventory of artificial intelligence usage by state agencies; provide

## Summary

This bill mandates an annual inventory and reporting of AI usage by Georgia state agencies, requires the Georgia Technology Authority to develop AI-related policies, and mentions repealing conflicting laws.

## Business Impact

If your agency uses AI in Georgia, you must report your AI usage annually or face potential penalties.

## Key Provisions

- Mandates annual inventory of AI usage by state agencies.
- Requires annual reports on AI usage to be submitted to the Georgia Technology Authority.
- Tasks the Georgia Technology Authority with developing and establishing AI-related policies.
- Mentions the repeal of conflicting laws.
