Summary

This bill mandates the University of Hawaii to create a wildfire forecast system and allocates funding for this initiative.

Business Impact

If you develop AI systems for environmental forecasting in Hawaii, you must comply with state requirements by 7/1/3000 or face potential funding issues.

Key Provisions

- Requires the University of Hawaii to develop a wildfire forecast system.
- Appropriates funds for the program's establishment.
