## Summary

Establishes a plan for generative AI use in state agencies, mandates risk assessments, guidelines, and reports to the Legislature by the Office of Enterprise Technology Services.

## Business Impact

If you operate a state agency in Hawaii, you must comply with new AI guidelines and risk assessments or face legislative scrutiny.

## Key Provisions

- Establishes a plan for generative AI use in state agencies.
- Mandates risk assessments by the Office of Enterprise Technology Services.
- Mandates the preparation of guidelines for AI use in government operations.
- Requires reports to the Legislature on AI implementation.
