Summary

This bill creates an Artificial Intelligence Working Group in Hawaii to develop guidelines for AI regulation and use.

Business Impact

If you develop or deploy AI technologies in Hawaii, you must comply with new guidelines established by the working group by 7/1/3000.

Key Provisions

- Establishes the Artificial Intelligence Working Group.
- Develops acceptable use policies for AI technologies.
- Focuses on regulation, development, deployment, and use of AI in Hawaii.
