## Summary

Mandates a study on AI use for safety in correctional facilities, with a report to the Legislature.

## Business Impact

If you consult on AI for corrections, you may be contracted for a feasibility study.

## Key Provisions

- Conduct a feasibility study on AI use for safety in correctional institutions.
- Authorize contracting with consultants for the study.
- Require a report to the Legislature.
- Appropriate funds for the study.
- Declare appropriation exceeds fiscal year 2024-2025 expenditure ceiling.
