Relating To Correctional Institutions.

Summary

This bill requires a study on the feasibility of using AI to enhance safety in correctional institutions and appropriates funds for this purpose.

Business Impact

If you operate correctional facilities in Hawaii, you must prepare for potential AI implementation by 2026 or face operational challenges.

Key Provisions

- Requires a study on AI feasibility for safety in correctional institutions.
- Mandates a report to the legislature by 2026.
- Appropriates funds exceeding the state general fund expenditure ceiling for 2024-2025.
- Allows contracting of consultants for the study.
- Effective date for appropriation is July 1, 2024.

Compliance Checklist

- Conduct a feasibility study on AI technology for safety improvements. | Who: Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation | Penalty: Potential operational challenges if not completed.
- Prepare to utilize appropriated funds for the study. | Who: Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation | Penalty: Failure to utilize funds may hinder study progress.
