Summary

This bill urges Hawaii's Department of Law Enforcement leadership to undergo training on AI-related crimes every two years.

Business Impact

If you lead a law enforcement agency in Hawaii, you must ensure your team undergoes AI crime training every two years to stay compliant.

Key Provisions

- Urges training for law enforcement leadership on AI-related crimes.
- Training to include topics like deepfakes and related technologies.
- Training recommended at least every two years.
