Summary

This resolution encourages Congress to pass two acts aimed at protecting artists and individuals from AI exploitation and unauthorized duplications.

Business Impact

If you create or distribute media content using AI, you must ensure compliance with new protections for artists or face potential legal challenges.

Key Provisions

- Encourages Congress to pass the NO FAKES Act.
- Supports the No AI FRAUD Act for protecting individual rights.
- Aims to safeguard against exploitation by AI technologies.
