Summary

This bill encourages Congress to pass two acts aimed at protecting original art and addressing AI-related challenges, based on the title and description.

Business Impact

If you create or distribute art using AI, you must ensure compliance with new regulations on authenticity or face legal consequences.

Key Provisions

- Encourages Congress to pass the Nurture Originals Act.
- Encourages Congress to pass the No AI Fraud Act.
- The specifics of AI-related concerns are unknown.

- Ensure compliance with authenticity regulations for AI-generated art | Who: Artists and distributors using AI | Penalty: Legal consequences for non-compliance
- Monitor legislative developments related to the proposed acts | Who: Businesses in the entertainment and art sectors | Penalty: Potential legal risks if unprepared for new regulations
