## Summary

This bill encourages Congress to pass legislation protecting artists and individuals from exploitation by AI technologies, with certified copies sent to key congressional leaders.

## Business Impact

If you create or use AI-generated content, you must ensure compliance with new protections for likeness and voice rights or face legal challenges.

## Key Provisions

- Encourages Congress to pass the NO FAKES Act.
- Supports the No AI FRAUD Act to protect against unauthorized duplications.
- Calls for a balance between artistic freedom and protection from AI exploitation.
- Recognizes the rights of publicity under Hawaii law.
- Aims to safeguard individuals' likenesses and voices from AI misuse.
