## Summary

HB1869 limits government use of facial recognition systems, with specific exceptions detailed in the bill.

## Business Impact

If you use facial recognition technology, ensure compliance with new government restrictions or face legal challenges.

## Key Provisions

- Section -4(a): Restriction on government use of facial recognition.
- Section -4(b): Exceptions for law enforcement, REAL ID compliance, and health emergencies.
- Section -4(c): Information from facial recognition not constituting probable cause.
