Relating To Violation Of Privacy.

Last Action (Jan 27, 2021): Re-Referred to GVO/EET, JDC.

Summary

SB156 limits Hawaii government's use of facial recognition systems, with specific exceptions for law enforcement and public health.

Business Impact

If you use facial recognition for public health at airports, ensure data is destroyed within 60 minutes.

Key Provisions

- § -4(a) Restriction on government use of facial recognition
- § -4(b)(1) Exception for law enforcement use with existing mugshots
- § -4(b)(2) Exception for REAL ID Act compliance
- § -4(b)(3) Exception for public health monitoring at airports
