## Relating To Facial Recognition Systems.

Introduced

Risk: Medium

Narrow/Targeted

Last Action (Feb 18, 2022): Report adopted; Passed Second Reading, as amended (SD 1) and referred to JDC/WAM.

## Summary

SB2293 limits the Hawaii Department of Transportation's use of facial imaging and thermal scanning systems to airports, with an appropriation included.

## Business Impact

If you operate airport facilities, ensure compliance with facial imaging system regulations by July 1, 2050.

## Key Provisions

- Section 2: Limits the use of integrated thermal scanner facial imaging systems to airports.
- Section 3: Appropriation for the maintenance and operation of the system.

## Compliance Checklist

- Ensure usage of facial imaging and thermal scanning systems complies with specified situations. | Who: Department of Transportation and any associated entities. | Penalty: Potential penalties for non-compliance are not specified.
