## Relating To Education.

Introduced

Risk: Medium

Narrow/Targeted

Effective: Jan 01, 2020 | Last Action (Jan 24, 2019): Referred to EDU/PSM, WAM.

## Summary

Mandates school safety upgrades, including locks, intercoms, and a facial recognition pilot program.

## Business Impact

If you provide facial recognition tech to schools, you must comply with pilot program standards by 2020.

## Key Provisions

- Equip all classroom doors with interior locks by January 1, 2020.
- Connect all school locations via intercom.
- Monitor school perimeters not secured by a physical barrier.
- Establish an emergency management plan aligned with federal guidelines.
- Implement a school safety facial recognition pilot program.
- Appropriate funds for the implementation of these measures.
