The bill requests the Department of Business, Economic Development and Tourism to form a working group on artificial intelligence with specific stakeholders to explore its applications and risks.

Business Impact

If you operate in Hawaii and use AI, you should engage with the working group to align with state recommendations by 2021 or risk missing opportunities.

Key Provisions

- Establishment of an Artificial Intelligence Working Group with specific stakeholders.
- Assessment of AI applications used in other states or countries.
- Evaluation of competitive advantages for Hawaii's economy.
- Identification of potential dangers of AI integration.
- Promotion of AI research and development in Hawaii.
- Submission of interim and final reports to the Legislature.
