- Establishment of an Artificial Intelligence Advisory Committee.
- Committee to evaluate AI applications and competitive advantages for Hawaii.
- Assessment of potential dangers and regulatory needs regarding AI.
- Inclusion of various stakeholders and experts in the committee.
- Submission of a report with findings and recommendations to the legislature.
