This bill requests Hawaii to form an advisory committee, including state officials and AI experts, to explore AI implementation and regulation in the state.

Business Impact

If you operate in Hawaii and use AI, you must stay informed about the committee's findings and potential regulations by 2020.

Key Provisions

- Establishment of an Artificial Intelligence Advisory Committee including state officials and AI experts.
- Committee to evaluate AI applications and competitive advantages for Hawaii.
- Assessment of potential dangers and regulatory needs regarding AI.
- Submission of findings and recommendations to the Legislature by 2020.
