Summary

The bill requests the Department of Business, Economic Development and Tourism to form a working group on artificial intelligence, including specific legislative representatives.

Business Impact

If you operate a business in Hawaii that uses AI, you may need to engage with the upcoming working group for insights by 2021.

Key Provisions

- Establishment of an Artificial Intelligence Working Group by the Department of Business, Economic Development and Tourism.
- Assessment of AI applications used in other states or countries.
- Evaluation of competitive advantages for Hawaii's economy and government.
- Identification of potential dangers of AI integration.
- Encouragement of AI research and development in Hawaii.
- Submission of interim and final reports to the Legislature.
