Summary

The bill requests the formation of an advisory committee to investigate AI implementation and regulation in Hawaii, with a report due twenty days before the 2020 Regular Session.

Business Impact

If you develop or use AI in Hawaii, you must engage with the advisory committee's findings by 2020 or risk non-compliance with future regulations.

Key Provisions

- Formation of an Artificial Intelligence Advisory Committee.
- Committee to evaluate AI applications and competitive advantages for Hawaii.
- Assessment of potential dangers and regulatory needs related to AI.
- Submission of a report with findings and recommendations twenty days before the 2020 Regular Session.

Compliance Checklist

- Engage with the findings of the advisory committee. | Who: Businesses and stakeholders using or developing AI in Hawaii. | Penalty: Potential non-compliance with future regulations.
