## IDPH-DIAGNOSTIC ALGORITHM

Last Action (May 19, 2023): Rule 19(a) / Re-referred to Rules Committee

## Summary

Hospitals must confirm diagnostic algorithms are certified and provide patients the option to be diagnosed without them before consent.

## Business Impact

If you operate a hospital in Illinois, you must ensure diagnostic algorithms are certified and obtain patient consent before use.

## Key Provisions

- Hospitals must confirm diagnostic algorithms are certified by relevant state departments.
- Algorithms must show equal or greater accuracy than traditional diagnostic methods.
- Patients must be informed when a diagnostic algorithm is used and consent to its use, with the option to be diagnosed without it.

## Compliance Checklist

- Confirm certification of diagnostic algorithms | Who: Hospitals | Penalty: Regulatory scrutiny or penalties may apply.
- Inform patients and obtain consent for algorithm use | Who: Hospitals | Penalty: Regulatory scrutiny or penalties may apply.
