Last Action (May 19, 2023): Rule 19(a) / Re-referred to Rules Committee

Summary

Hospitals must confirm diagnostic algorithms are certified and accurate before use, and patients must consent to their use.

Business Impact

If you operate a hospital in Illinois, you must ensure diagnostic algorithms are certified and obtain patient consent before use.

Key Provisions

- Hospitals must confirm diagnostic algorithms are certified by relevant state departments.
- Algorithms must show equal or greater accuracy than other diagnostic methods.
- Patients must be informed and consent to the use of diagnostic algorithms.
- Patients must be given the option to be diagnosed without the algorithm.

Compliance Checklist

- Confirm certification of diagnostic algorithms | Who: Hospitals | Penalty: Potential legal repercussions for non-compliance
- Obtain patient consent before using diagnostic algorithms | Who: Hospitals | Penalty: Potential legal repercussions for non-compliance
