## AUTONOMOUS VEH REQUIREMENTS

## Summary

HB2053 amends the Illinois Vehicle Code to regulate autonomous vehicles, requiring documentation for Level 2 vehicles and prohibiting Levels 3-5 for consumer use.

## Business Impact

If you sell autonomous vehicles, you must submit documentation and fees or face penalties.

## Key Provisions

- Defines 'autonomous vehicle' with specific automation capabilities.
- Requires manufacturers to submit documentation and pay a fee before selling or operating autonomous vehicles.
- Establishes an Automated Driving Systems Review Committee to evaluate vehicle automation levels.
- Permits only Level 2 autonomous vehicles for consumer sale and registration.
- Mandates annual reporting from vehicle owners on usage and collisions.
- Prohibits the sale or operation of Level 3, 4, or 5 autonomous vehicles for consumer use.
- Imposes penalties for operating or selling prohibited autonomous vehicles.

## Compliance Checklist

- Submit documentation regarding driving automation level and pay a fee | Who: Manufacturers of autonomous vehicles | Penalty: Class A misdemeanor and vehicle impoundment
- File an annual report on vehicle usage and incidents | Who: Owners of Level 2 autonomous vehicles | Penalty: Potential penalties not specified
