INS-ADVERSE DETERMINATION

Passed Both Chambers

Summary

The bill mandates that only clinical peers make adverse determinations in health care plans using automated processes, effective January 1, 2025.

Business Impact

If you operate a health care plan using automated decision-making in Illinois, you must ensure clinical peer review of adverse determinations by January 1, 2025.

Key Provisions

- Only clinical peers can make adverse determinations based on medical necessity.
- Utilization review programs must certify compliance with the National Committee for Quality Assurance.
- Programs using automated processes must apply objective, evidence-based criteria.
- Definition of 'adverse determination' modified to include decisions made using automated processes.

- Ensure clinical peer review of adverse determinations | Who: Health care plans and utilization review programs | Penalty: Potential penalties for non-compliance not specified
- Certify compliance with accreditation standards | Who: Utilization review programs | Penalty: Potential penalties for non-compliance not specified
