## SAFE AUTONOMOUS VEHICLE ACT

Last Action (Mar 10, 2023): Rule 19(a) / Re-referred to Rules Committee

### Summary

The Safe Autonomous Vehicle Act allows manufacturers to initiate autonomous vehicle projects under specific conditions and liability provisions, with a focus on compliance.

### Business Impact

If you manufacture autonomous vehicles in Illinois, you must notify the Secretary of State and self-certify your project to avoid penalties.

### Key Provisions

- Manufacturers must notify the Secretary of State to commence autonomous vehicle projects.
- Manufacturers are liable for incidents caused by their automated driving systems.
- Unauthorized operation of vehicles with automated systems incurs a \$10,000 fine for first violations.

### Compliance Checklist

- Notify the Secretary of State before starting an autonomous vehicle project | Who: Motor vehicle manufacturers | Penalty: Potential fines for non-compliance
- Maintain incident records and provide summaries to the Secretary of State and NHTSA | Who: Motor vehicle manufacturers | Penalty: Potential fines for non-compliance
