Summary

HB4625 mandates digital literacy instruction in Illinois schools, starting in elementary, effective July 1, 2024.

Business Impact

If you operate a school district, you must implement digital literacy programs by July 1, 2024.

Key Provisions

- Section 27-20.07: All school districts must provide digital literacy skills starting in elementary school.
- Digital literacy instruction includes digital citizenship, media literacy, and AI literacy.
- Instruction must be developmentally appropriate and guided by the State Board of Education.
