## STATE AGENCIES-AI SYSTEMS

### Summary

This bill mandates Illinois state agencies to comply with AI trustworthiness and transparency standards and submit algorithmic impact assessments.

### Business Impact

If you deploy AI systems in Illinois state agencies, you must submit an algorithmic impact assessment to relevant authorities immediately.

### Key Provisions

- Requires compliance with NIST's AI Risk Management Framework.
- Mandates submission of algorithmic impact assessments for AI systems.
- Establishes oversight by chief AI officers appointed by agency executives.
- Department of Innovation and Technology to create standardized assessments.
- Specifies compliance timeframes for state agencies and funded entities.

### Compliance Checklist

- Submit an algorithmic impact assessment based on NIST standards. | Who: State agencies and entities deploying state-funded AI systems. | Penalty: Non-compliance may result in unspecified penalties.
- Ensure compliance with trustworthiness, equity, and transparency standards. | Who: State agencies and entities deploying state-funded AI systems. | Penalty: Non-compliance may result in unspecified penalties.
