Summary

The CATCH Fentanyl Act aims to establish a pilot program to enhance cargo inspection processes at land ports of entry.

Business Impact

If you operate in cargo inspection, you must implement fentanyl detection technology by the pilot program's start date or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Establishment of a pilot program to assess technology use in cargo inspections at land ports of entry, enhancing the inspection process
