## IDPH-DIAGNOSTIC ALGORITHM

## Summary

Hospitals must ensure diagnostic algorithms are certified, provide patients with options before use, and report annually on the algorithms.

## Business Impact

If you operate a hospital in Illinois, you must confirm diagnostic algorithms are certified and obtain patient consent before use.

## Key Provisions

- Hospitals must confirm diagnostic algorithms are certified by relevant departments.
- Algorithms must show equal or greater accuracy than other diagnostic methods.
- Patients must be informed and consent to the use of diagnostic algorithms.
- Hospitals must report annually on the algorithms they use.

## Compliance Checklist

- Confirm certification of diagnostic algorithms | Who: Hospitals | Penalty: Potential regulatory scrutiny
- Inform patients and obtain consent for algorithm use | Who: Hospitals | Penalty: Potential legal challenges
