Summary

The bill mandates informed consent from patients before licensed mental health professionals use AI tools in treatment.

Business Impact

If you provide mental health services in Illinois using AI, you must obtain patient consent and disclose AI use or face fines up to \$10,000 per violation.

Key Provisions

- Requires informed consent from patients before using AI tools in mental health services.
- Mandates disclosure of AI tool usage to patients prior to service provision.
- Amends multiple professional practice acts to include AI-related disciplinary grounds.
- Empowers the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation to adopt rules for AI use.
- Establishes penalties for violations, including fines up to \$10,000.
- Aligns AI regulations with existing professional conduct standards.
