Summary

SB0306 defines 'autonomous vehicle' and sets requirements for their operation, including the need for a human safety operator for certain activities.

Business Impact

If you operate autonomous vehicles for transport, ensure a human safety operator is present to comply with SB0306.

Key Provisions

- Defines 'autonomous vehicle' (Sec. 1-105.3a)
- Requires compliance with federal standards for registered autonomous vehicles (Sec. 12-1000)
- Mandates a human safety operator for certain transport activities (Sec. 12-1000)

Compliance Checklist

- Ensure a human safety operator is present during operation. | Who: Operators of autonomous vehicles. | Penalty: Potential penalties for non-compliance not specified.
