AUTONOMOUS VEH REQUIREMENTS

Summary

SB1471 regulates autonomous vehicles in Illinois, requiring documentation for Level 2 vehicles and prohibiting Level 3-5 sales.

Business Impact

If you sell autonomous vehicles in Illinois, submit documentation to the DOT or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Defines 'autonomous vehicle' (625 ILCS 5/1-105.3a)
- Manufacturers must submit documentation and pay a fee (625 ILCS 5/12-1000(a))
- Level 2 vehicles can be sold; annual reporting required (625 ILCS 5/12-1000(d))
- Prohibits sale/operation of Level 3-5 vehicles (625 ILCS 5/12-1000(e))
- Penalties for unauthorized sales or modifications (625 ILCS 5/12-1000(g))

Compliance Checklist

- Submit documentation regarding vehicle automation level and pay a fee | Who: Manufacturers of autonomous vehicles | Penalty: Class A misdemeanor for unauthorized operation
- File an annual report on mileage and incidents | Who: Owners of Level 2 autonomous vehicles | Penalty: Potential penalties for non-compliance not specified
