Summary

SB246 establishes requirements for health insurance issuers using AI or automated systems, effective August 1, 2026. This preliminary analysis is based on the title and description only.

Business Impact

If you operate as a health insurance issuer using AI, you must comply with new requirements by August 1, 2026, or face penalties.
